

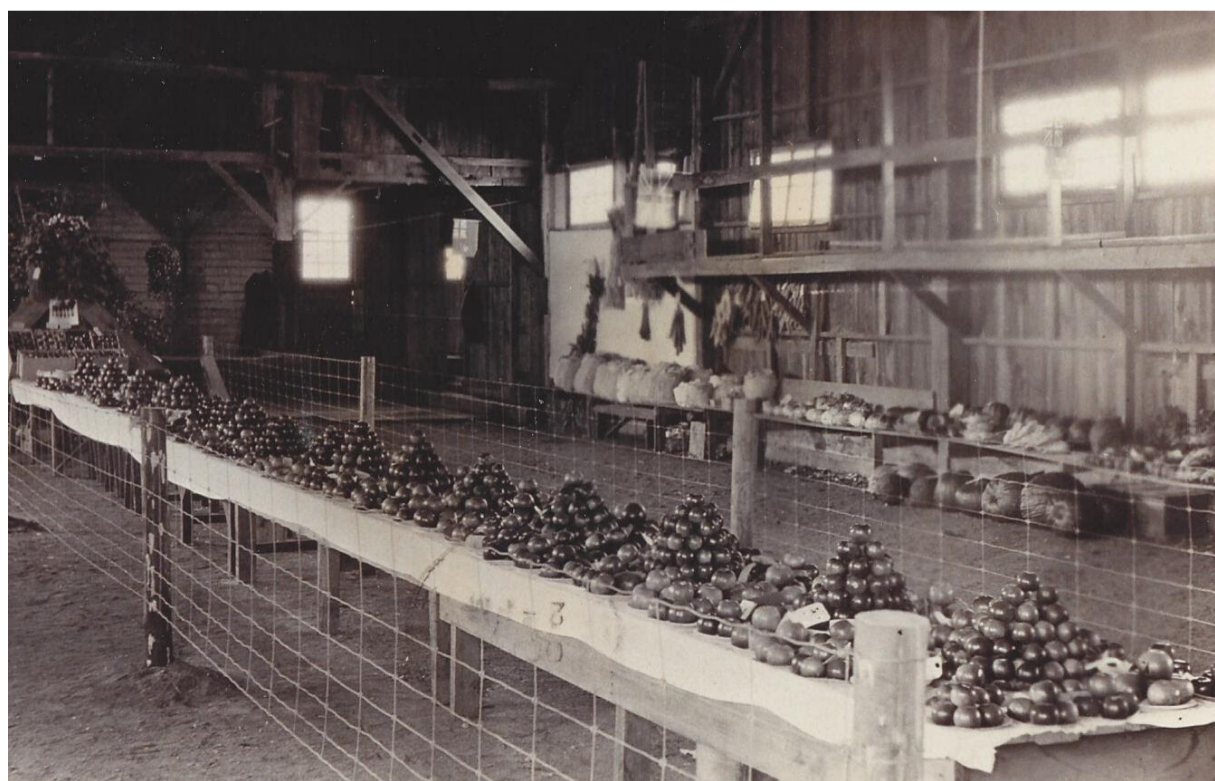


THE OAAS 175TH CONVENTION AND HOMECOMING!



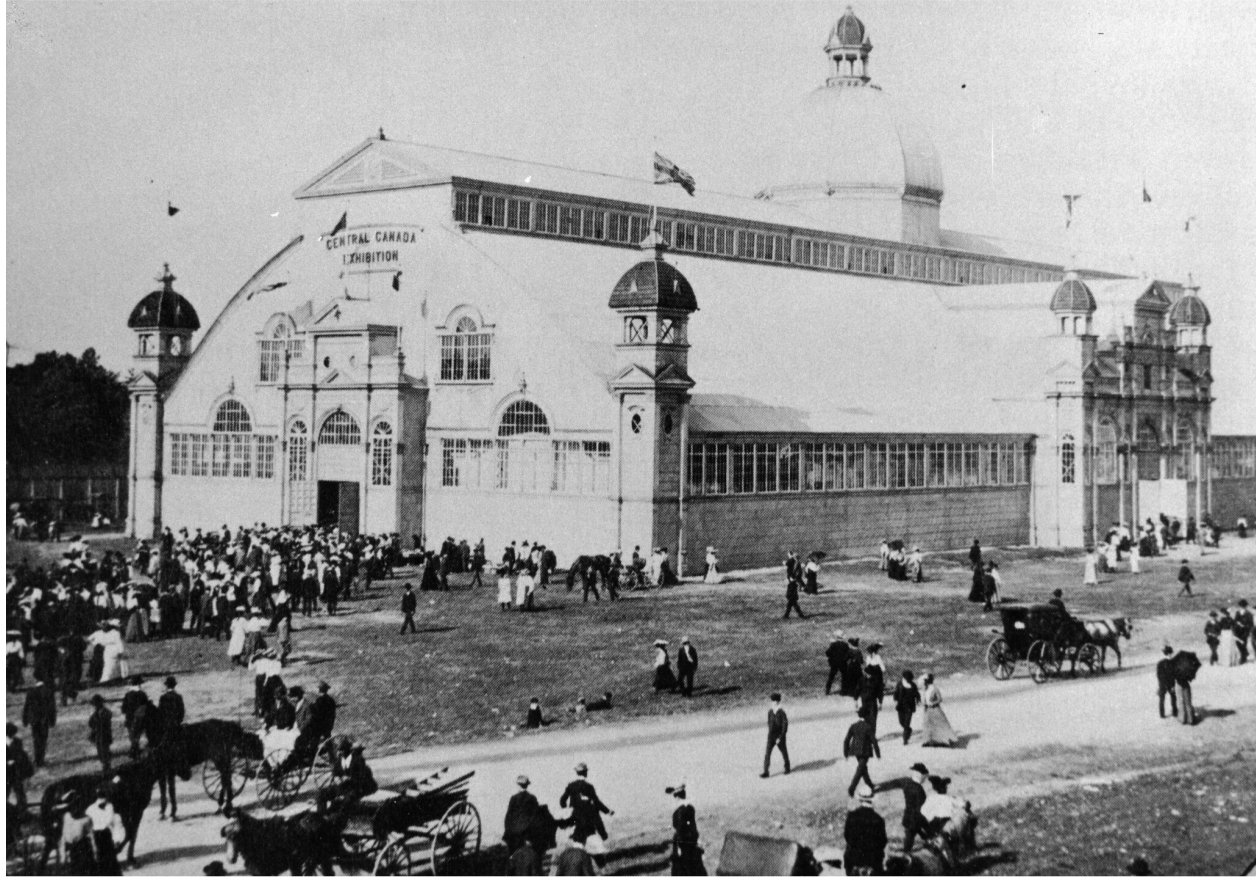
